4. Entering at least ONE team ceremonies or American Indian competition/evaluation.
5. Entering at least ONE team athletic competition.
6. Participation in any NOAC non-athletic competition or activity, such as Lodge History, Web Site, OA Battlestars, Camping Promotion, Newsletter, Brotherhood Chorus, and Brotherhood Band.
7. Representation by the lodge at the 2002 NOAC National Council of Chiefs (NCOC).
8. 75% of the Arrowmen in the lodge contingent earned the Brotherhood Award for individual NOAC participation.
9. Completion and submission of this application in advance of the 2002 NOAC.
