_____ **ARM BANDS:** German silver, brass, copper, etc.

_____ **BELT:** Loom beaded, etc. Well constructed with colorful designs.

_____ **LEG COVERINGS:** Ribbon work, leather with beadwork, clouts and trailer.

_____ **GARTER and SIDE TABS:** Finger woven or beaded.

_____ **BELLS:** Properly worn. Jingle bells, copper, brass, nickel, etc.

_____ **MOCCASINS:** Leather, hard sole.

_____ **HAND OBJECTS:** Fan, mirror board, cane, etc.

_____ **OVERALL APPEARANCE:** Outfit well constructed. Fine quality craftsmanship exhibited.
